The main campus provides education for students from year seven to ten with the main, year 11 and 12 pathways being to Bendigo Senior Secondary College. The second campus (BFLO- Bendigo Flexible learning Options) is an alternative setting and is a collaborative partnership between the six government secondary school providers in Bendigo that aims to re-engage learners.
